Workers open their genital orifice to sort the males from the females.



Males are force-fed, while females are gassed or ground up alive.

Then, around 85% of them are placed in individual or collective battery cages.



They cannot stand up, turn around or stretch their wings.



Over 12 days, they are force-fed through a 25-cm metal tube.



This forced overfeeding causes wounds and diseases.



1 million ducks die every year during the force-feeding period.



At the slaughterhouse, they are stunned and then their throats are cut.



A liver that has expanded to 6 to 10 times its normal size is extracted.



Foie gras: not so good after all.
